# 67th Minoh Citizen Exhibition

- 1. Objective** To have an exhibition that any Minoh citizen can participate in, to foster a society that cultivates individuality and lifelong learning.
- 2. Location** Minoh Culture and Communication Center **South Building (minami kan)**  
(5-10-23 Minoh, Minoh City) **(previously Naka Kindergarten)**  
✂The location has changed from this year.
- 3. Exhibition date** 23 November (Saturday, public holiday) - 1 December (Sunday) 2024  
10:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. **(last entry 5:30 p.m.)**  
✂Will close at 3:00 p.m. on 1 December (Sunday) **(last entry 2:30 p.m.)**
- 4. Requirements** Those age 15 and over who live, work or study in Minoh City  
(Excluding Junior High School students. Members of clubs/classes operating in Minoh City can apply.)
- 5. Categories • Regulations** 1 item per category can be entered per person ✂Free to enter

## 6. Application

- The Citizen Exhibition requires **pre-application** (during the application period).
- **Works will not be accepted without pre-application.**
- You can apply via **reception counter, online form or post.**

- Application period: 17 October (Thursday) - 30 October (Wednesday) 2024 (non-negotiable)
- How to apply (Japanese only): Reception Counter / Online Form / Post

- Warning: Works must be delivered in-person on this date to be accepted.  
(cannot be sent in advance via post, etc.)
  - Please complete the required information on the "Safekeeping receipt" and "Artwork tag" and bring it with you.
  - The "Artwork tag" must be attached to the back of the artwork before delivery
  - We do not accept packaging materials, etc.

## 8. Warnings

- Artworks are restricted to those you have made yourself that have not been shown before. You cannot submit the same work more than 1 time. If you do not follow these rules, your entry will be cancelled (even after the results are announced).
- Artworks thought to violate nature conservation and public order and morals will not be accepted.
- Portrait rights and copyright of exhibited artworks is the responsibility of the artist.
- Ikebana and similar works cannot be accepted. Also, electricity cannot be used.
- Objections to the location of the exhibition and our methods will not be accepted.
- Please attach metal fittings and a cord or rod to artworks that need to be hung up.

- Works can be collected from the exhibition location in exchange for a safekeeping receipt.
- There is nowhere to keep them after the exhibition period. You must collect works during the designated time.

※Artworks that are not collected on the designated day will be disposed of.

## 12. Notes

- Care will be taken with the artworks but the organisers take no responsibility for damage due to 'acts of god' or natural disasters. Those submitting works should take out insurance if needed.
- Some works may have photos taken of them which will be used for PR purposes to promote the Minoh Citizen Exhibition. Attendees are also allowed to take photos of the works, etc.
- Current or former members of the Minoh City Art Association can exhibit works but they will not be judged.

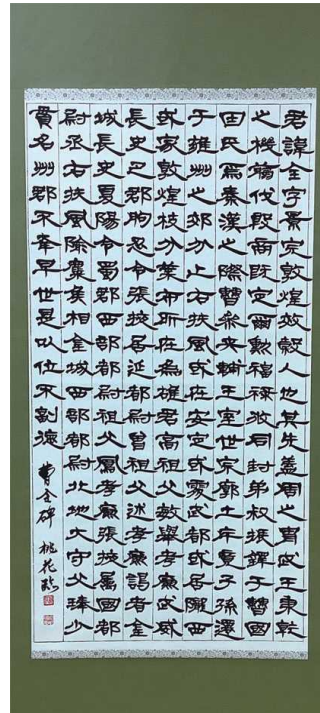

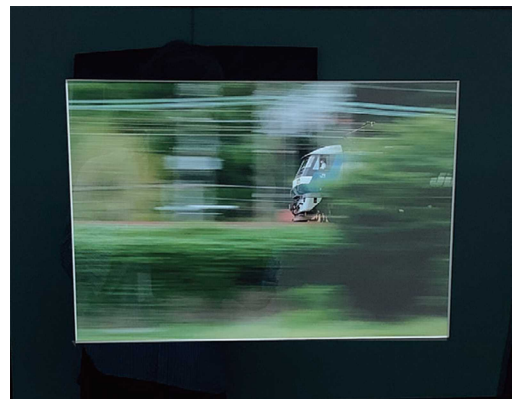
