Disposal of unexploded bomb



Please evacuate to an area outside the evacuation zone by 10:00 a.m.

※ If you do not evacuate on time, bomb disposal operations will be delayed. Please cooperate by evacuating on time.

※ Please be sure to lock your doors and windows and turn off all heat sources.

※ On the day of the evacuation, staff will visit all affected households starting around 9:30 a.m. to confirm that everyone has evacuated.

【Bomb disposal operation time】

From 10:00 a.m until safety measures such as the removal of detonators are completed (expected around evening)

※ Entry into the evacuation zone is prohibited during this time.

【How to confirm that the bomb disposal operation is complete】

Once the removal work is complete, we will post an announcement on the city home page and official social media accounts.

(We will also provide updates on the day's progress and latest information.)

Even if you do not go to a temporary evacuation site, as long as you are outside the evacuation zone, you may stay wherever you like.

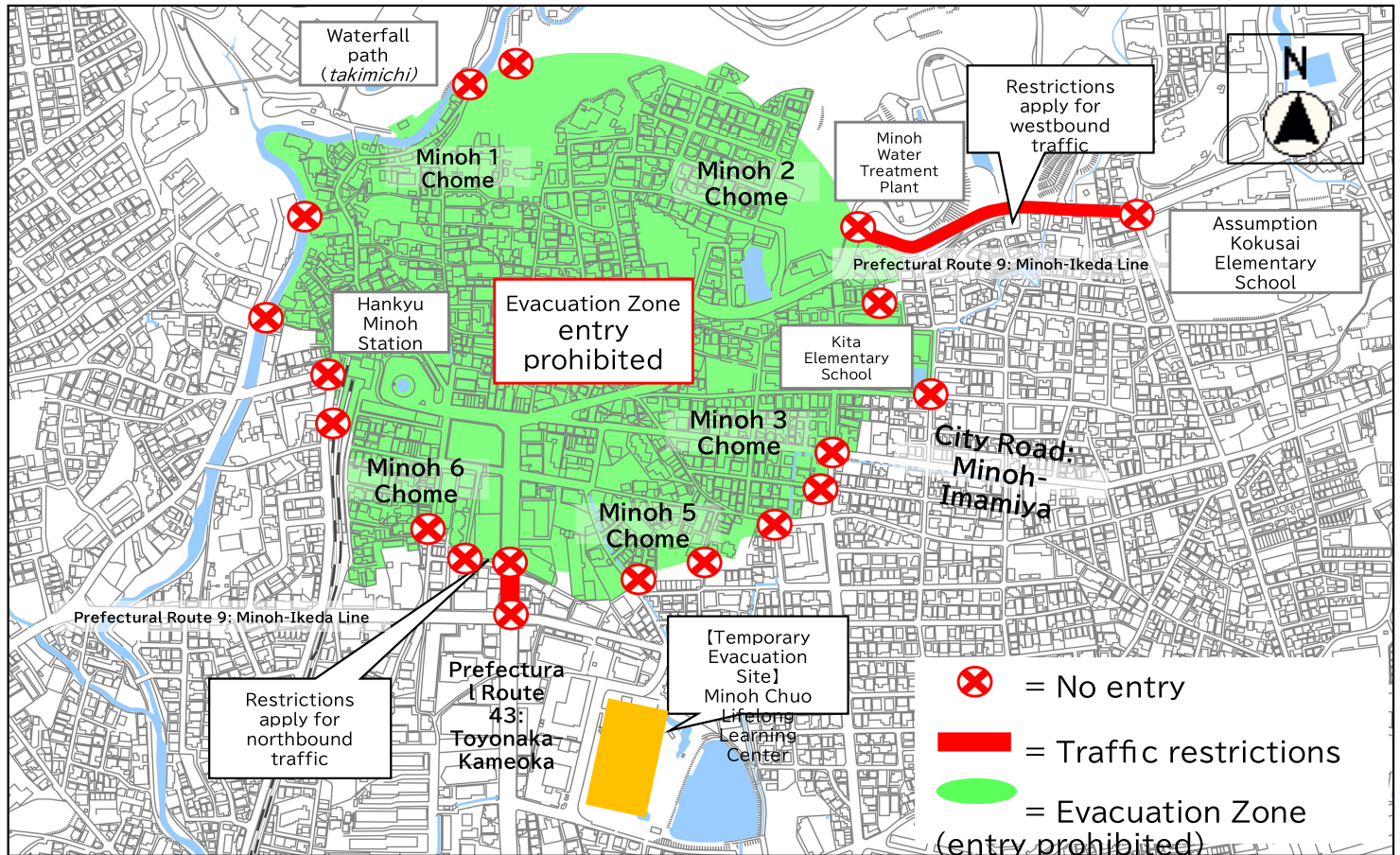
※ Free parking spaces are not provided.

※ Pets will be accepted at the temporary evacuation site if they are placed in a pet carrier, bag or similar container (they are not permitted inside the building)

Evacuation zone area and areas with traffic restrictions

Anyone living or working in the evacuation zones listed below **must evacuate to an area outside these zones.**



About public transportation

●Hankyu Railway Minoh Line (between Ishibashi Handai-mae Station and Minoh Station)

- Services will be temporarily suspended until restriction are lifted.
- The last trains are as follows:
Ishibashi Handai-mae Station: Departs at 9:40 a.m. bound for Minoh (arrives at 9:46 a.m.)
Minoh Station: Departs at 9:50 a.m. bound for Ishibashi Handai-mae Station (arrives at 9:56 a.m.)
- Access is prohibited within the Minoh Station premises and outside the station, including the Minoh Station Plaza and surroundings areas.

●Hankyu Bus

- For the Minoh Sanroku Line and the Saito Line, service between Minoh-Kayano Station and Hankyu Minoh Station will be suspended.
- Service from Minoh-Kayano Station will be suspended starting at 9:00 a.m., and service from Hankyu Minoh Station will be suspended starting at 8:43 a.m.
- Service will resume in stages as soon as the restrictions are lifted.
