

Due to disposal of unexploded bomb: 《Minoh City・1st notice》



Evacuation Notice

An **unexploded bomb** was discovered on July 17 at a construction site in Minoh 2-chome, Minoh City. On **Sunday, September 27**, the Ground Self-Defense Force will carry out operations to remove the unexploded bomb. During the removal operation, to prepare for any possible emergencies, **entry will be prohibited into the warning zone (evacuation zone)**, which extends approximately 300 meters in radius from the removal site. (Please see the reverse side.) Anyone residing or working within the evacuation area is requested to **move to a location outside the warning zone (evacuation zone) on the day of the operation**. We appreciate your cooperation.

■ Date and Time of disposal operation

Sunday, September 27, 2026 Scheduled to begin at 10:00 a.m. [Disposal operation will be carried out in any weather]

*Please leave the evacuation zone by 10:00 a.m.

* Even if you do not go to a temporary evacuation site, as long as you are outside the evacuation zone, you may stay wherever you like.

* We cannot provide an estimated completion time as it depends on the condition of the unexploded bomb and other factors. We will announce the end of the evacuation order via the city's website, social media, and public announcement vehicles as soon as the disposal operation is complete.

■ Temporary Evacuation Site

Minoh City Chuo Lifelong Learning Center (5-11-23 Minoh, Minoh City) **scheduled to open from 9:00 a.m.**

Note: The Chuo Lifelong Learning Center does not have a parking lot.

* The temporary evacuation site is provided only to offer a place to stay during the hours when evacuation is required on the day of the operation. Please bring your own food, water, and any other items necessary for your stay.

Also, in case you feel unwell, please bring your My Number Card or Health Insurance Eligibility Certificate, medication record book, regular medications, and drinking water.

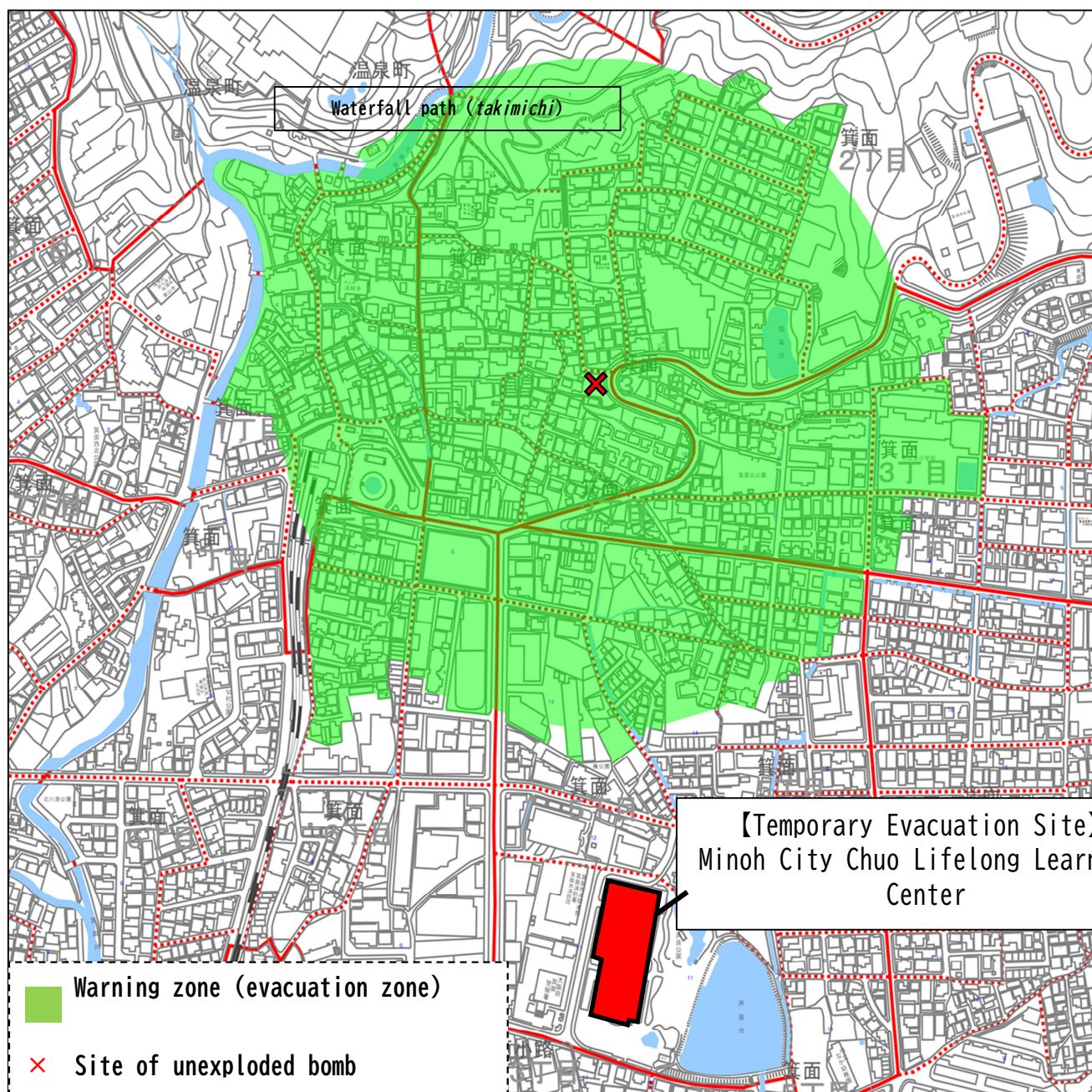
◆Traffic Restrictions

On the day of the disposal operation, traffic restrictions are planned on roads surrounding the evacuation zone, and public transportation services may be suspended or rerouted. Details will be announced as soon as they are finalized.

◆Important Notes

- ① Please turn off all electrical appliances except those absolutely necessary.
- ② Please turn off the gas and water completely.
- ③ Please take great care to ensure all fire hazards are eliminated and that all doors and windows are securely locked.

Evacuation Zone and Temporary Evacuation Site



The addresses listed below are subject to evacuation. *Please note that for some addresses, only certain house numbers are subject to evacuation.

- Minoh 1-chome: 1, part of 3, 4-9
- Minoh 2-chome: 1-6, part of 7, 8-13
- Minoh 3-chome: 1, 2, part of 3, 4, part of 18
- Minoh 5-chome 1, 2, part of 3, part of 4, part of 13, part of 14
- Minoh 6-chome part of 1, 2, 3, part of 4

*These areas have been designated as evacuation zones in accordance with Article 63 of the Basic Act on Disaster Management.
